This exciting course is available to students who achieved an overall pass in the BTEC First Diplomas in Health and Social Care, or Children’s Care, Learning and Development. It helps you to develop your skills, knowledge and understanding of health and social care in the early years – vital if you are planning to continue studying or starting work. You will study six units which consist of four mandatory units and two specialist units. These are: working to quality practice in care settings, working with service users in care settings, behavioural awareness in care, applied practical care in settings, child development and investigating child protection services.
