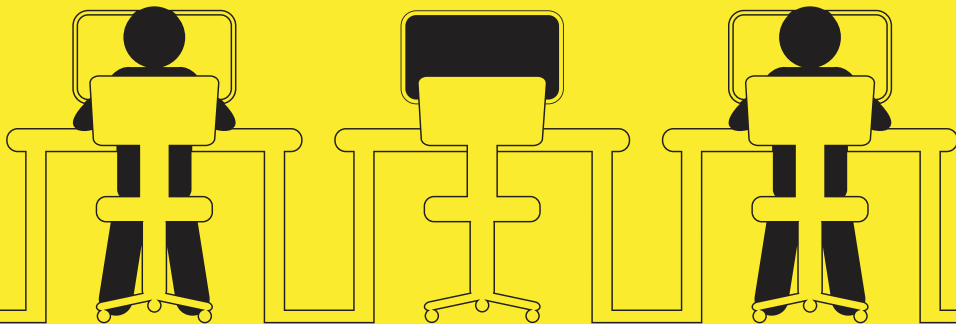

Project SEARCH is an internship programme providing real work experience and support to find full time paid work. Internships take place on the Homerton Hospital site; combining classroom learning, career exploration and job skills training, through carefully selected work placements across various departments.

This programme helps young people with learning disabilities and autism experience and secure paid permanent jobs.

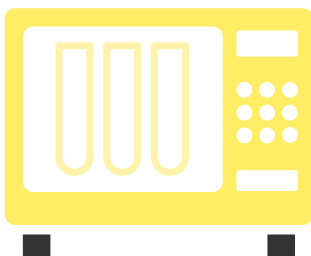
Want to work but need help?

Project SEARCH A typical day

The project is based at the Homerton University Hospital.

9am -10am Classroom based activities such as IT and Employability.

10am -3pm Working on your placement with a department, initially supported by your job coach.

3pm -3.30pm Classroom based reflection time, reviewing the skills you are developing.

Project SEARCH Entry Requirements

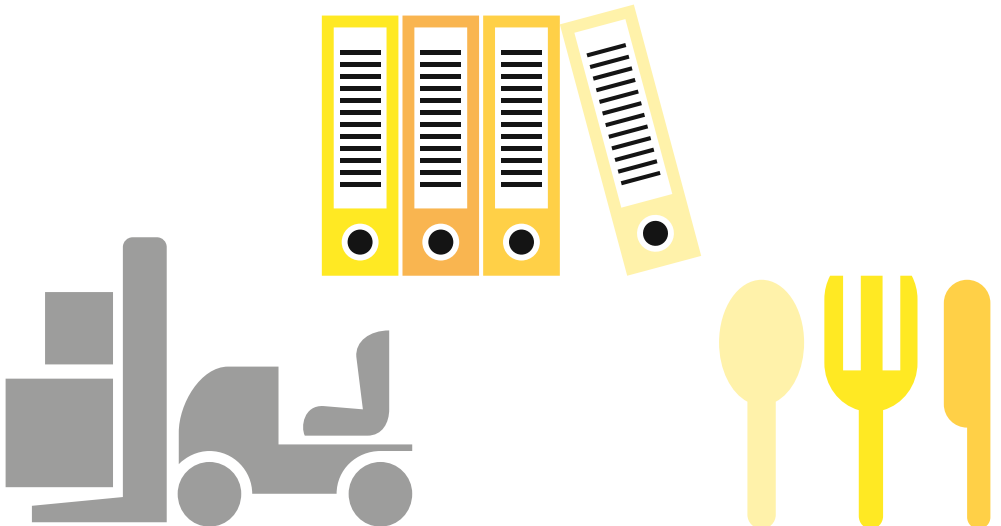
You will need to:

- Have the desire and plan to move into work at the conclusion of the **Project SEARCH** programme
- Be available to undertake an internship programme, October 2018-July2019
- Take direction from a workplace supervisor.



How does it work?

The Hackney Supported Employment Team will support you through a three part programme of work training, via a series of three work placements in different departments within Homerton NHS Trust. A Tutor and Job Coach will support you through these internships for three periods of approximately eight weeks, over the academic year.



Project SEARCH aims to prepare you for paid work, either within the NHS or within a variety of sectors, such as Hospitality, Retail, Construction and many more!
